#4: Denver, lakewood, aurora

The Denver Metro area is the 19th-largest metropolitan area in the United States. From 2010 to 2018, the U.S. Census Bureau shows that the Denver-Lakewood-Aurora area has welcomed approximately 388,000 over the 8-year span. Every month, thousands of transplants move into the mile-high city. With a strong economic forecast, limited housing inventory, and the allure of stunning mountain views - as well as Denver's other niceties - the metro market continues to gain momentum.

Local Tip: Take a stroll down old Larimer Street, one of the oldest parts of downtown Denver. In the '60s, Larimer Street was at risk of being torn down but was saved by preservationist and real estate developer Lisa Crawford. Today, it's a charming take on how the new can coexist with the old.

The median home value in the Denver Metro is \$437,537, which is a 2.3% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 4.2% within the next year.

#3: COLORADO SPRINGS

Named 'One of the Best Places to Live', Colorado Springs is drawing attention as Colorado's next boom in real estate. Properties on average cost approximately \$150,000 less than those in Denver, and interest among millennials is growing faster than any other city in the country. Just last year, El Paso County added approximately 7,400 jobs and the economy is projected to grow with several military institutions employing 60,000 residents.

Local tip: While visiting Garden of the Gods or the Broadmoor are never bad ideas, those looking for a unique experience should try the Airplane Restaurant. Complete with a 1953 Boeing KC-97 as the restaurant's centerpiece, it's an aviation lover's dream.

The median home value in Colorado Springs is \$316,396 which is a 6.3% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 5% within the next year.

#7: FORT COLLINS, GREELEY, LOVELAND

Thanks to Northern Colorado's formidable oil reserves, Weld County has seen massive growth. This area includes Greeley, home to the University of Northern Colorado, and emerging Fort Collins, where Colorado State University is located. Fort Collins and the surrounding areas have added over 30,000 new jobs since 2014 due to a tech boom from local startups.

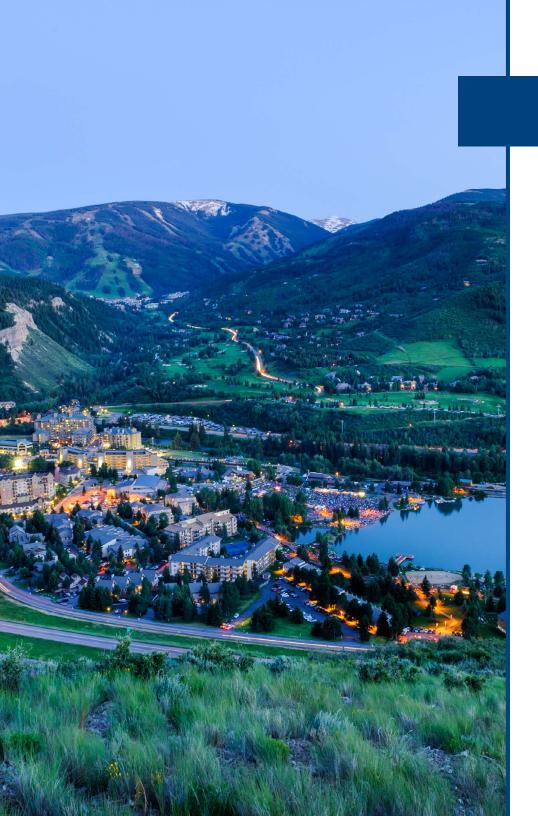
Local tip: Fort Collins is home to many notable Colorado breweries. Sample your favorite Odell brew right from the source, then hit several other breweries on your way home and treat your designated driver to dinner in Old Town.

The median home value in Fort Collins is \$417,499, which is a 2.4% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 3.9% within the next year.

Western Colorado

#1: Durango, Silverthorne, Steamboat, Grand Junction

Whether you're into skiing, hiking, biking, rafting, or just looking for world-class views, a mountain property in Western Colorado is the place to be. Demand for small towns in areas like Silverthorne might have set you back \$400k a decade ago, but today you'll need approximately \$700k to claim one.

Local tip: there's still a lot to do outside of ski season. Check out the Keystone Wine and Jazz festival, which takes place in mid-July.

The median home value in Silverthorne is \$600,399, which is a 3.9% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 4.2% within the next year.
