#4: Downtown san antonio

'San Antone' has long been sentimentalized by country and western singers, and rightfully so. There's just something about taking a nighttime stroll along the river amid the soft glow of the city lights, the restaurants, and the architecture that makes you feel at peace, if not a bit romantic. Its central location and proximity to the city's highest concentration of office space also makes it a great place for both empty nesters and young professionals alike.

Local Tip: When you have visitors come into town, walk them by the Alamo and make your way to the Little Rhein Steak House. A San Antonio staple for over 50 years, the Little Rhein is located in the historic La Villita, a place where human activity can be traced back to the 1500s.

The median home value in Downtown San Antonio is \$419,084, which is a 2.4% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 2.9% within the next year.


#3: TOBIN HILL/THE PEARL DISTRICT

As the beating heart of the Pearl District, the historic Hotel Emma is a 19th-century brewhouse turned 146-room work of art. One part industrial-chic, one part steampunk, one part classical opulence, and a bar that's beyond imagination, the hotel sets the mood of the surrounding neighborhood.

Local tip: Not surprisingly, there's no shortage of chic little small plate haunts, but catch a meal at Supper and it'll change you. Attached to the Hotel Emma, the design language continues through the restaurant, making it one of the most unique restaurant experiences in the country.

The median home value in Tobin Hill is \$311,753, which is a 6 % increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 4.1% within the next year.

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#7: West canyon lake


For those who prefer to get out of town but don't want to be too far from civilization, West Canyon Lake might be the answer. Located approximately 45 miles from San Antonio, this coveted Texas Hill Country escape has a lot to offer in terms of views, parks, and water-based recreation.

Local tip: Take a minute to relax on a bench in Canyon Overlook Park, or take the dogs for an evening walk to take in all that Canyon Lake has to offer.

The median home value in West Canyon Lake is \$276,963, which is a 6.9% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 4.8% within the next year.







#1: RIVER CHASE/ NEW BRAUNFELS

Just east of Canyon Lake is the sprawling suburb of River Chase. It wouldn't be Texas if you couldn't live big, and there's definitely square footage to be had in River Chase. Big homes come with a big price, however, with one of the area's lowest 'days on market' counts, that doesn't seem to be slowing anyone down

Local tip: combat the summer heat by grabbing a burger and a cold one at the Lone Star Float House and Grill. Nestled along the banks of the Guadalupe River, the Lone Star Float House serves those traveling by intertube or car.

The median home value in New Braunfels is \$275,532, which is a 3.3% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 3.7% within the next year.

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#3: SOUTH CONGRESS Keep Austin Weird

With chic boutiques, fancy eats, and temples of Americana like the Continental Club, South Congress has long grabbed headlines for being one of the country's hippest neighborhoods. And while that attention might be shifting to more affordable areas of the city, SoCo will always ooze charisma and be the scene that attracted people there in the first place.

Local tip: For the adventurous, worldly eaters among you, purchase tickets to Otoko's multi-course omakase Japanese dining experience. Not your style? Not a problem, grab a quick slice at Homeslice Pizza and wash it down with some brews and hard-drivin' Texas-style blues at the Continental.

The median home value in South Austin is \$620,572, which is a 6.3% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 4.0% within the next year


#7: East austin

Long time residents of Austin may remember the east side of town as a vibrant, diverse, working-class neighborhood, but these days it's the place to be. Here you'll find galleries, condos, food trucks, craft cocktail bars, and more than enough places to sip high-end espresso all juxtaposed with relics of East Austin's humble and artistic past.

Local tip: Seek out Discada's tacos. A humble street-taco trailer in East Austin, Discada's menu is limited to a few perfected styles of the Mexico City staple, but it's about as close to street-food heaven as you can get.

The median home value in South Austin is \$462,338 which is a 5.2% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 4.6% within the next year.







#1: Brushy Creek

Located about 30 -minutes north of Austin, the family-friendly suburb of Brushy Creek isn't too far from the action, yet it's home to one of Austin's most desirable school districts. With a median home price that hovers around the mid-300s, Brushy Creek is quickly becoming Austin's go-to area for young families.

Local tip: With Lake Travis so close, it's hard not to spend summer days in and around the water, and nights in downtown Austin.

The median home value in Brushy Creek is \$323,560 which is a 2.3% increase from the previous year. Zillow predicts this will rise another 4.4% within the next year.
