


# INTRODUCING ONE OF THE HOTTEST REAL ESTATE MARKETS:

#### #4: Bridgeport

They also enjoy a diverse spread of small businesses, such as The Starving Artist Studio and Artworks, crafted by the creative community in town. 
Local tip:

## #3: STAR CITY

Star City is an endearing city with small-town charm as it's home to just over 2,000 residents. This town is located in Monongalia County and follows the flow of the Monongahela River. Residents enjoy a myriad of recreational water activities, hiking trails, and well-maintained green spaces in this lovely slice of West Virginia.

## #2: Morgantown

Down the river from Star City, Morgantown is one of the largest cities in the state with just over 30,000 residents. Home to West Virginia University, there are a number of related activities that everyone can enjoy, from the University Art Museum to Nath Sculpture Garden to the WVU Core Arboretum and beyond.

For a real Mountaineer experience, visit Pies & Pints to enjoy local craft beers and artisan pizza. With over 20 beers on tap, there are plenty of varieties to explore. Signature pies like the Baja Bean and Thai invite you off the beaten path to try unique flavors.

## **#1**: CHEAT LAKE

Cheat Lake is a metro suburb of east Morgantown located on a lake which is fed by the Monongahela River and flows into the Cheat River.
