#5: CLIFTON North Cincinnati






#7: MOUNT ADAMS - Southeast Cincinnati


We can't stress enough that you should get over to Celestial Street and eat yourself into a food coma at the Mt. Adams Bar and Grill.

There should be a cooling off period over the next year, but do not expect or be surprised by skyrocketing home prices as the development of lower-income areas continues. Zillow considers this a "Sellers' Market" with a moderate short-term slowdown in median home prices. Be on the lookout for a significant uptick in home and rental prices with the introduction of FC Cincinnati's \$250 million West End stadium in 2021.
